## **Federal Law on the Issuing of Regulations**

The text of this Law is as provisionally agreed (subject to agreement of the political leaders) in the Technical Committee on Laws, save for highlighted parts which represent the suggestions of the United Nations to resolve outstanding issues.

**Section 1    *Short Title***

This Law may be cited as the “Federal Law on the Issuing of Regulations”.

**Section 2    *Issuing regulations***

Regulations shall be issued by the Presidential Council and shall come into force upon publication or on the date set forth in the Regulations. Any member of the Presidential Council may, within a period of seven days from the decision to issue the Regulations, stating specific reasons affecting the vital interests of either constituent state and/or potentially harming the relations between Greek Cypriots and Turkish Cypriots, request that such Regulations be laid before the Senate. The Senate may, within a period of 40 days from such laying, quash such Regulations.

**Section 3    *Delegation of power***

A law may enable the Presidential Council to delegate the power to issue Regulations thereunder relating to matters of a technical nature to one of its members having the relevant competence. Such Regulations shall come into force upon publication or on the date set forth in the Regulations.
